
Literacy

Talk for Writing - We will continue using storytelling and Talk for Writing to further develop our writing skills, focussing on a Defeat the Monster story.



Explanation writing will be developed using our Ancient Greeks and science topics for inspiration.

SPAG - daily focussed sessions will be used to learn spelling rules, punctuation and grammar which will be re-enforced within the children's fiction and non-fiction writing.

Science

We will be working scientifically and investigating:

Forces and Magnets - we will be exploring forces through pushing

and pulling, investigating friction, along with the strength and poles of magnets.

Electricity - we will be investigating simple circuits and learning how to draw circuits. We will then be using our skills to make a game in DT.



Maths

In maths this term we will be focusing on measure, telling the time and fractions. Please encourage your children to read clocks whilst you are out and about
